Rules

Teams are 2, 3 or 4 members. (Laps must be completed in 2s), each team must provide their own lights and emergency lights. 4 hours of racing, plus a quiz to gain extra points.

Start – 4pm, last lap must begin before 8pm. A mountain bike event, consisting of a 5km lap, within Kirroughtree Forest.

Riders MUST have previous night riding experience (aged 12 or over) and adequate off road mountain bike specific lights,

and they must carry an emergency light. Riders must ride the route in 2's and be within 10 metres of each other at all times

on the course. The route will be technically challenging in places. Riders will be given a planet for each lap completed, and the object is to get as many planets as possible in 4 hrs.

Each planet contains a dark skies question, and riders can find all the answers in the Kirroughtree visitor area for bonus points. The event starts, changes over and finishes from thebreakpad bike shop.

All entries must be posted by 8th of March 2010

Early booking is strongly recommended to guarantee entry.

Entries may be accepted on the day – but not guaranteed.
